As many of you know, earlier this year we had two joint projects with First Presbyterian Church to collect much-needed items for non-profits and shelters in our area. Both collections were successful and now we have another opportunity to join forces with our friends at First Presbyterian Church.

The Outreach Committee is asking you to save this date: Saturday, August 22nd. This collection, which is dubbed, "Got Your Pack" has a goal of collecting 150 new backpacks and school supplies to be distributed, by Cameron Community Ministries, predominately in the Lyell-Otis neighborhood.

In addition to backpacks, we are asking for the highest-use items such as three-ring binders, subject dividers, pens, pencils, glue sticks, tape and scissors. Some of the scissors should have rounded ends for small children and, again, all items must be new.

This collection will be run as it has been in the past. Items may be dropped off in the First Presbyterian Church parking lot between 9 a.m.-1 pm, again, on Saturday August 22nd.

Also, if you do not have time to shop, a check payable to "Cameron Community Ministries" with "Got Your Pack" written in the memo line would be greatly appreciated. The check could be dropped off during the day of the collection day or mailed to First Presbyterian Church at 21 Church Street, Pittsford 14534.
